This past year, we received ARC Applications for changes to the exterior of homes, decks, and docks. If you are considering new home construction or modifications to the exterior of your home, please file an ARC Application prior to selecting a contractor. Please don't wait until the night before a construction crew arrives before contacting ARC for approval! Normally, two weeks' notice is sufficient. Please go to our website and read our Covenants and the Architectural Review Committee Operating Practices. The website is boxwoodgreen.org/.

If you have any questions about the ARC process, please call or email an ARC member who will help eliminate confusion and facilitate the process.

If you are planning to sell your home, an ARC member is required to make an exterior inspection of the home prior to the sale to verify it is in conformance with Covenants. The results of the inspection are included as part of the HOA Packet which will be given to the buyer. So, please request this inspection prior as soon as you put your home on the market. This way you will know if any corrections are needed.
